This year Art in the Park will again be held in conjunction with Squirrel Fest on August 17, 2019. Our location will be in the Longview Civic Circle where Squirrel Fest will be held. **There will be a change in booth assignments this year. If you must have a corner, please indicate it on the application. Otherwise your booth will be placed in a line with other booths with only the front entry. The corner booths are limited and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.**

If you are a returning vendor there is no need to re-jury, just send in your application by the deadline. New vendors will be juried by 3 photos; all printed on a single sheet of letter size paper or 3 standard photos. Please label entries with (1) your name (2) medium and (3) email address. If you want your photos returned, enclose a SASE large enough and with adequate postage so they may be returned to you. You may also email photos of your work to: maf43@comcast.net.

There will be no refunds after your application is accepted.

Checklist of Requirements:

1. Fill out the Artist Commitment Form with the names of all participants in your booth. Each participant must sign the Columbian Artists Association's Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release.
2. Send 3 photos of art to be sold at Art in the Park. Or email photos of your work to maf43@comcast.net.
3. Enclose a check for \$40.00 made payable to: Columbian Artists Association.
4. Mail the above required items to Columbian Artists Association, PO Box 2862, Longview, WA 98632, by the deadline **August 1, 2019**.
5. You will be notified of your acceptance by email.

Rules, Regulations and Miscellaneous Information:

Artists must be at least 18 and will provide their own display equipment (canopies, tables, chairs, etc.) **Canopies must have weights attached to the corners and that are not a tripping hazard.** All art must be created by the artist and be original from concept through completion. All art must be for sale. No commercially manufactured items or work from kits will be allowed. Commercially reproduced copies and/or cards of your art may not constitute more than 25% of your total display. CAA reserves the right to accept only artwork we feel is in keeping with the spirit of our arts and fine crafts event. We will ask that any work not in keeping with the character of our event be removed.

The CAA event organizer will assign 10X10 spaces and you will be notified at check in of your booth location. All booths must be set-up and ready for sales by 8:30 on Saturday morning and remain open until 5:00. No early breakdown is allowed. All vehicles must be removed from the lawn by **8:30 on the morning of set up**. You must be present the entire day (no reps without the artist). You are responsible for collecting the required sales tax and remitting it to the state. You are encouraged to provide a sales receipt to your customers. You are responsible for cleaning up your space and the area around it after the show is over. There will be no refunds for inclement weather.

The Columbian Artists Association is a 501-3(C) non-profit organization. After event expenses, proceeds from the application and spaces fees will go toward supporting the arts locally. We do not discriminate in regards to age, disability, race, religion, national origin, gender, or sexual orientation.
