Show to be held at the Cowlitz County Museum, Kelso.

Tuesday, March 22 – 10 am-4 pm- Artists bring in entries

Wednesday, March 23 - Judge awards ribbons

Thursday, March 24 – 4:30 – 6:30pm - Sponsors make selections for awards.

Thursday, March 24 - 7:00pm - Secondary Judge for sponsor awards not yet given

Saturday, March 26 – 2 pm – 4 pm – Reception and Awards; Remain open until 6 pm

Saturday March 26 – April 15 - Show open from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm Tuesday- Saturday

Saturday, April 16 - 12:00 – 2:00 pm - Artists pick up work.

Saturday, April 16- 11:30 - People's Choice award

2:00 pm – 3:00 pm - Clean up

Entries: Open to artists 18 years and older from Cowlitz, Clark, Wahkiakum, Lewis, Pacific, Clatsop, and Columbia counties. Entries must be originals and entirely the work of the entrant. No copies or likenesses to other artists' or copy-righted photographers' work are acceptable. This includes all copyrighted images in both 2D and 3D. Entries must have been completed within the past two years and not previously entered in a Columbian Artists Show. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE. A total of three pieces per artist** will be allowed. If an artist enters both 2D and 3D, the combined total may not exceed three.

2-Dimensional Art: Categories are **oils, watercolors, acrylics, and mixed media** (includes pastels, pen, pencil, hand-pulled prints, and collages). **NOT ACCEPTED:** reproductions, work that has been photo shopped, computer art, giclee prints, crafts, offensive, or wet work. One piece may measure up to 60 framed inches (vertical plus horizontal); other pieces may be no more than 40 framed inches (vertical plus horizontal). Watercolors may be without glass or acrylic if properly finished. Work in pen, pencil, and pastels must be under glass or Plexiglas. Oils and acrylics may be on wide gallery-wrapped canvas or framed. **Only wire hangers** accepted. No saw-toothed hangers or clip frames are accepted.

3-Dimensional Art: Art may not weigh more than 60 lbs. have a height of more than 60 inches, or a width of more than 30 inches. Some 3D art may be juried out due to space restraints. 3D artists are required to provide their own pedestals and must follow the same "original art" requirements as 2D.

ENTRY FEE: NON-MEMBERS pay \$20.00 per piece and MEMBERS pay \$15.00 per piece. All entries will be juried and judged. By entering the show and paying the entry fee, artists are agreeing that their art meets all the above stated requirements. Art that does not meet the above standards will not be accepted for the show. A commission of 20% will be charged for each piece sold, payable to the Columbian Artists Association.

In addition to judged awards, a CAA Memorial Award, Sponsor Awards and one Peoples' Choice Award will be given. **ALL WORK MUST BE PICKED UP ON SATURDAY APRIL 16 BETWEEN 12:00 AND 2:00PM.** Let CAA know if you assign someone to come in your place. The Columbian Artists Association and the Cowlitz County Museum assume no responsibility in case of loss or damage. Every precaution will be taken to protect entries.
